

GreenEDULARP: Green Actions in School using Educational Live-Action RolePlaying (EduLARP)”
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The 3-day EduLarp workshop held in Gmina Melgiew, Poland, from 27th to 29th April 2023, brought together six partners from Poland, Greece, Sweden, and Estonia to provide training to teachers. The workshop started with a meeting where each organization presented



themselves and the GreenEduLarp project, followed by the presentation of all the materials that had been prepared in a step-by-step manner.

The workshop focused on several modules covering different aspects of EduLarp. The modules covered EduLarp as a learning environment, the concept and roles of LARP implementation, playing the LARP created, and reflection time. The modules were conducted by experts in their respective fields and were designed to provide teachers with a comprehensive understanding of EduLarp.

During the workshop, participants engaged in discussions about organizing EduLARP games, place accessibility, props, and items creation, character creation, managing a game, debriefing, and learning outcomes. The workshop also included a presentation by the Larp for Climate project, which gave a climate LARP example for inspiration.

The workshop concluded with a general reflection on the LTTA and the evaluation of the GreenEduLarp Curriculum and tools and lesson plans by the participants. The workshop successfully achieved its objective of training teachers on how to use EduLarp as a learning tool.
