GreenEduLarp project is finalising

In July 2024 will end the Erasmus+ *GreenEduLARP*. 3-years long project aimed at using the tool of EduLARP for Climate Change Education (CCE). This way students but also teachers get involved in the topics related to Climate Change learned in the classroom with real-life situations. The aims of the project was:

- to **empower teachers** with new competencies in environmental education using LARP,
- to **enhance students** with confidence and agency skills through the LARPing

methodology and teamwork while also learning about climate change and building concepts around it,

- to **create accessible online material** for further use and capitalization,
- to **build a transnational strategy** on how to adapt EduLARP methodology in school curricula.

engaging, hands-on activities that foster environmental awareness and action.

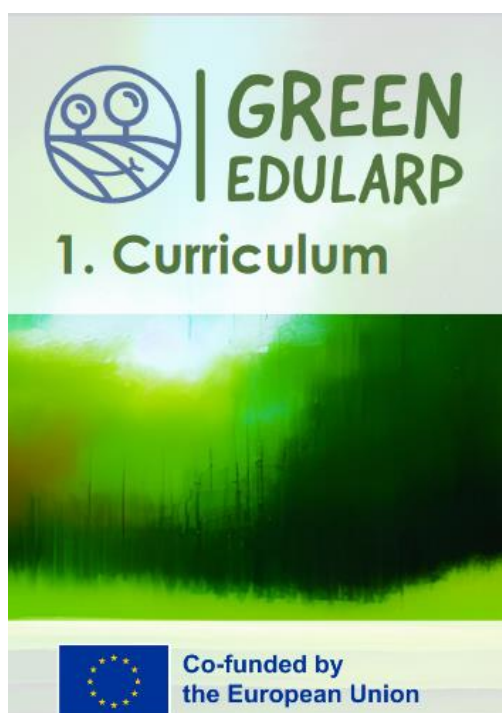
Each lesson plan includes:

GreenEduLarp project Meetings and Multiplier Events in Poland.

On March 20, 2024, a conference was held to disseminate the results of Erasmus projects for teachers

and local authorities of the Świdnik district in Poland. Beata Adasik presented the GreenEduLarp project, detailing the concept of LARP, its



phases, how to prepare a LARP, and where to find LARP instructions. Then the students participated in LARP workshops.



On April 24, 2024, a Round Table meeting was held with representatives of local authorities and policymakers in our region involved in education. The purpose of the meeting was to present the GreenEduLARP project and the teacher and educator support materials developed during the project. Attendees were also introduced to the positive feedback for the GreenEduLARP project provided by a Member of the Council for the Improvement of the Education System at the Ministry of Education and Science (MEiN). The meeting was conducted in a very pleasant atmosphere, and the results of the GreenEduLARP project and the LARP method itself garnered significant interest from policymakers. We hope

that local authorities will support teachers who work using the EduLARP method.



On April 26, 2024, the Maria Wojcik Primary School in Krępiec hosted a well-attended Multiplier Event that spotlighted the LARP (Live Action Role-Playing) method as an innovative educational tool. Attendees were treated to a series of instructional videos showcasing the LARP method in action and its application within the GreenEduLARP project. These videos were a product of collaborative efforts between various project partners and offered insights into the engaging and interactive nature of the method.

Additionally, participants were introduced to a comprehensive set of support materials tailored for teachers, including a thoughtfully designed Curriculum and an extensive Teacher's Toolkit. These resources, essential for

implementing LARP in educational settings, were developed with great attention to detail and have already been translated into Polish to ensure accessibility for local educators.

During the conference, a vibrant exchange of ideas took place as participants actively engaged in discussions and asked insightful questions about the LARP method and its practical applications in the classroom. The general consensus among attendees was a strong endorsement of the EduLARP method's potential to revolutionize teaching and learning experiences.

Many expressed their enthusiasm for the methodology and confirmed their intention to incorporate the materials provided by the GreenEduLARP team into their own teaching practices. This enthusiastic response highlighted the transformative impact of the LARP method and its promise as a valuable asset in modern education.



The last three months have been a very intense time, not only for the project itself but also for trainings and conferences where the GreenEduLARP project, along with its results and materials produced during the project's duration, were presented. These were very promising meetings with teachers, educators, and animators working in education, as well as with policymakers who play a significant role in shaping educational offerings. It also involved many meetings with young people and working on joint projects using the EduLARP method, with the LARPs themselves serving as the culmination of all activities.

«GreenEduLARP: Μια καινοτόμος μεθοδολογία για την Περιβαλλοντική Εκπαίδευση στο πλαίσιο Ευρωπαϊκού Προγράμματος Erasmus+ plus»

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Περίληψη
Η περιβαλλοντική εκπαίδευση αναδεικνύεται ως κρίσιμος παράγοντας για την προώθηση της βιώσιμης ανάπτυξης και προστασίας του περιβάλλοντος. Η Ευρωπαϊκή Ένωση αναγνωρίζει την ανάγκη ενίσχυσης της περιβαλλοντικής ευαισθητοποίησης και εκπαίδευσης σε όλα τα επίπεδα της κοινωνίας. Στο πλαίσιο του προγράμματος Erasmus+ GreenEduLARP, η AeliaPath Κουσεπ συνεργάζεται με οργανισμούς και σχολεία από διάφορες ευρωπαϊκές χώρες για την ανάπτυξη της μεθοδολογίας GreenEduLARP. Μέσω αυτής της συνεργασίας, έχουν αναπτυχθεί ένα εκπαιδευτικό εργαλείο για εκπαιδευτικούς, το GreenEduLARP. Αυτό το εργαλείο περιλαμβάνει προετοιμασία, υλοποίηση και αξιολόγηση του εκπαιδευτικού παιχνιδιού GreenEduLARP. Εισαγωγή
Η περιβαλλοντική εκπαίδευση αναδεικνύεται ως ουσιώσιμος παράγοντας για την προώθηση της βιώσιμης ανάπτυξης, της προστασίας του περιβάλλοντος και της αειφορίας. Η Ευρωπαϊκή Ένωση έχει αναγνωρίσει την ανάγκη για ενίσχυση της περιβαλλοντικής ευαισθητοποίησης και εκπαίδευσης σε όλα τα επίπεδα της κοινωνίας. Μέσω της περιβαλλοντικής εκπαίδευσης, οι πολίτες αποκτούν τις γνώσεις, τις δεξιότητες και τις στάσεις που τους επιτρέπουν να συμβάλουν στην προστασία και βελτίωση του περιβάλλοντος, του ταυτόχρονα προωθείται η διατήρηση της πολιτιστικής και βιολογικής ποικιλότητας.
